## 2023 OKLAHOMA FAST FACTS

From May, 2023 to June, 2023, every member in every Oxford House located in Oklahoma was asked to take a confidential, anonymous survey. 1022 members were presented with the survey, and 979 members participated, resulting in a report of 95.8% of the total membership in Oklahoma.
